**31.02 : READ AND RECORD THE PROCEEDINGS OF 30<sup>TH</sup> GOVERNING COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON 05-07-2022 :**

The Proceedings of the 30<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Governing Council held on 05-07-2022 was circulated among the members and no comments were received.

**31.03 : ACTION TAKEN ON THE DECISIONS OF 30<sup>TH</sup> GOVERNING COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON 05-07-2022 :**

**26.12 New Initiatives / Proposal :**

**Item No. 1 : Progress of AICTE Grant received :**

AICTE has sanctioned Rs. 3.00 Crores under IDC Scheme for construction of Hostel for Differently Abled for the year 2020-21 and the 1<sup>st</sup> installment amount of Rs. 1.50 Crores has been sanctioned on 12-06-2020.

The construction work was allotted to M/s Mansun Interiors, Bengaluru through E-Procurement process.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> installment amount of Rs. 1.20 Crores has been released by AICTE on 14-12-2022.

So far 85% of work has been completed and Rs. 1.81 Crores of expenditure has been made. The remaining work will be expected to be completed by March 2023.

**Item No. 5: NBA Accreditation status :**

NBA Accreditation for 4 Programmes namely Architecture Assistantship, Commercial Practice, Computer Science & Engineering and Electronics & Communication Engineering is valid upto 30-06-2024.

Using 1 of the 4 credentials of NBA Accreditation, a new course in Apparel Design & Fabrication Technology was started in the year 2022-23.

Preparations are going on for submitting the compliance for continuation of Accreditation in the month of January 2024.

**30.09 New Initiatives :**

**Item No. : 1 Starting of new Diploma in ADFT**

Principal informed that, a new programme in Apparel Design & Fabrication Technology has started from the academic year 2022-23 with an intake of 30 and 16 students have admitted to the course. The necessary Teaching & non-teaching staff are appointed for first year. Necessary equipments / furniture are also procured. The classes are going on and the first batch of students of ADFT will be appearing for exams in Jan – Feb 2023.

**Item No. : 2 Starting of one year Certificate Course on Jewellery Making**

Principal informed that, for the students with intellectual disabilities (apart from HI, OH & VI students) a certificate course in Jewellery Making of one year duration has been started on 20-08-2022 by the department of Jewellery Design & Technology. 16 students with intellectual disabilities are admitted to the course and Rs. 20,000/- has been fixed for course fee. The training is going on.

**Item No. 3 : Action taken on implementation of MoU signed between JSSPDA & NITTTR, Chennai**

Principal brought to the notice of the GC that, an MoU was signed between JSSPDA & NITTTR, Chennai for the Academic Development on 03-06-2022. Under this MoU, various activities are planned in the following areas :

- Development of LMS for students with disabilities
- Organizing FDPs in technical, general and disability areas.
- Organizing National Seminar
- Industry collaboration
- Support for Curriculum Development and pedagogical training.
- Faculty & students exchange programme

In this connection, different levels of meetings are conducted with NITTTR for development of LMS. A proposal has been submitted to NITTTR for conduction of FDPs and a National Seminar in the year 2023.

**Resolution : Noted & Approved.**

**Item No. 4 : Strengthening of infrastructure for the next level development :**

Principal informed that, to admit more number of differently abled students and also strengthening the academic and administrative development, a concept proposal has been submitted to the Management for approval.

In this proposal, it is envisaged that

- Introduction of new Diploma in emerging areas.
- New courses for persons with intellectual, mental illness, autism, specific learning disabilities (other than HI, OH & VI).
- Expansion of hostel facilities both accommodation and dining.
- Strengthening of Training & Placement cell, examination section & disability support unit.
- Creation of sports complex cum auditorium to accommodate nearly 1,000 students.
- Procurement of modern equipments & furniture.

Principal informed that, the necessary financial support under CSR initiatives will be mobilized.

As per the suggestions of Sri N Narendra, to introduce new subjects for Electronics & Communication Engg. and Computer Science & Engg. in the areas of IoT, Geo fencing, cloud computing etc.

Principal informed that, the Curriculum 2021 (C-21) is introduced in the year 2021-22 and the final year curriculum will be revised in the year 2023-24. The necessary steps will be taken during the revision of final year curriculum, these subjects will be included in line with the Board curriculum for 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> Semester of CS & EC programmes.

**Item No. 5 : International linkages with JSSPDA**

As per the suggestions by Dr. B Suresh, Director (T) regarding establishment of linkages with International institutes of the same kind. Principal informed that, discussion with Dr. Ganesan Shivaramakrishnan, Post Doctoral Research Fellow, Belgium regarding establishment of linkage between foreign institutes and he assured to do the needful. Also contacted Mr. Soni Rahman, CEO, Knowledge Splice Services, A Global provider of consulting, outsourcing, learning and technology services regarding the same. Further M/s Cheshire Disability Trust, Bengaluru has assured for establishing a linkage with International institutes.

**Discussion :**

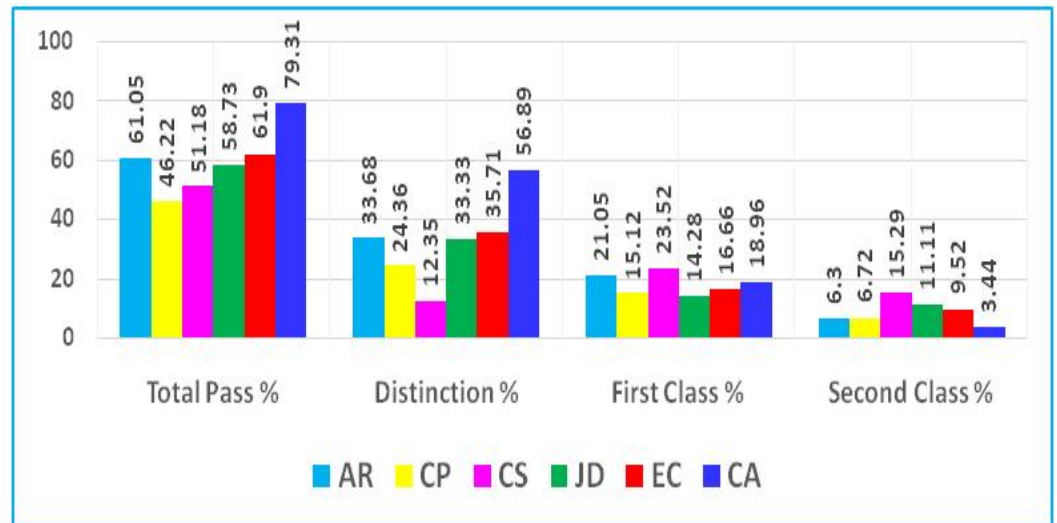
